

SALUTE TO 6 GROUP RCAF

*Commemorating the 75th Anniversary
of the Formation of Bomber Command's
"All Canadian" RCAF Bomber Force*

Saturday August 19th



Although hundreds of Canadians were serving with Bomber Command in Royal Air Force squadrons at the outbreak of war, the Canadian involvement was one that grew as the war progressed.

6 Group RCAF Bomber Group was formed during October 1942, becoming a force of fourteen squadrons. The Canadian Group flew a total of 40,822 sorties. 271,981 hours were flown, and 814 aircraft were lost.

10,250 Canadians were killed serving with Bomber Command.
